Car Approximately 15 minutes from Taniyama I.C.

Kyushu Expressway Kagoshima I.C. → Ibusuki Skyline Taniyama I.C. → Prefectural Road 219 → National Route 225 → National Route 226 → Hirakawa Zoological Park

Time required from the following locations (by car)

- From Kagoshima-chuo Station.....Approx. 35min.
- From downtown Tenmonkan.....Approx. 40min.
- From Ito World Kagoshima City Aquarium.....Approx. 45min.
- From Kagoshima Airport.....Approx. 75min.


- Cashless payment is not available for tickets shared with Kagoshima Aquarium.
